

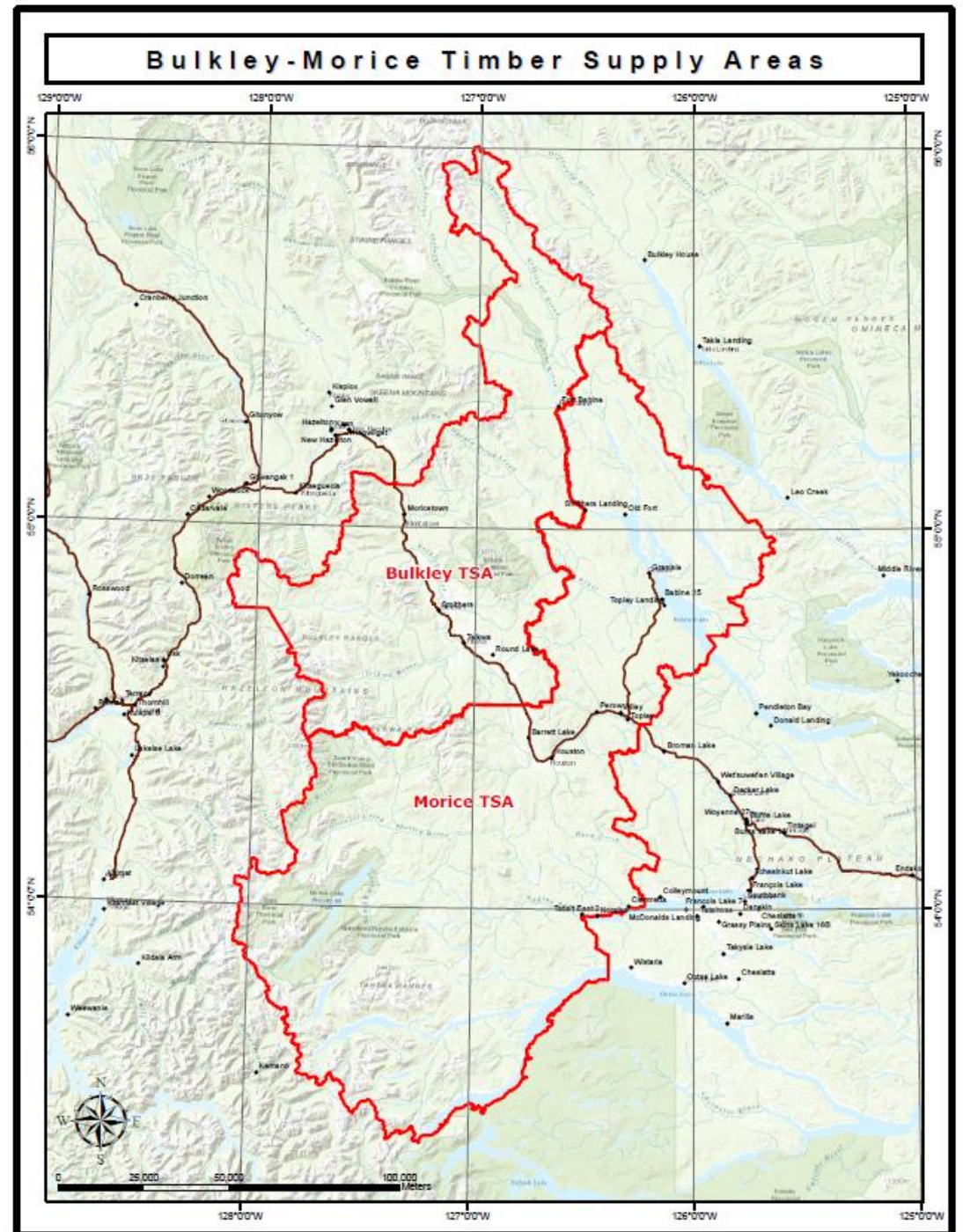


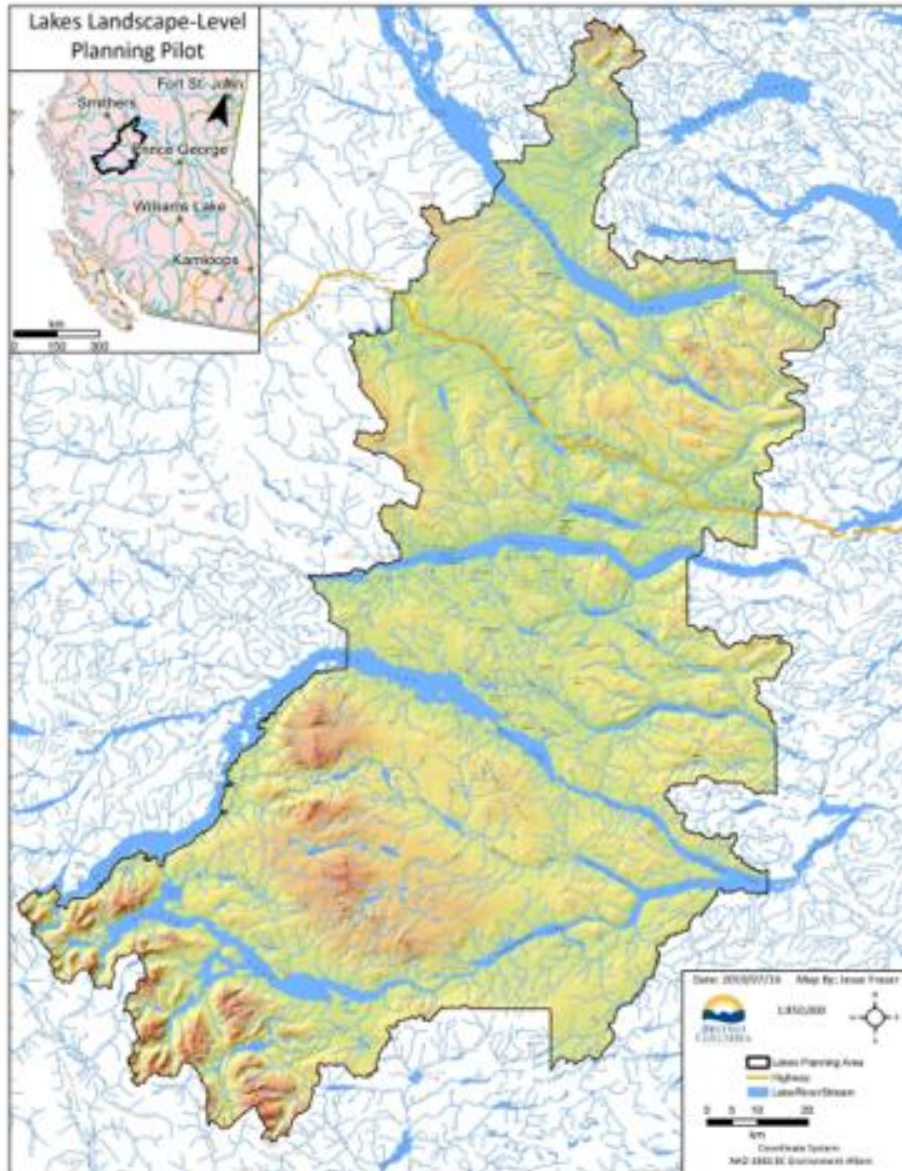

Introducing Forest Landscape Planning

A single Forest Landscape Plan (FLP) would replace all Forest Stewardship Plans within a management unit (e.g. the Lakes Timber Supply Area).

An FLP provides clear management direction to achieve desired outcomes for forest resource values.

Allows for forest planning to be forward-looking and to occur at a broader landscape scale.

5 FLP Objectives

Support protection and conservation of the environment

Support production and supply of timber in FLP area

Prevent, mitigate, and adapt to impacts of significant disturbance to forest and forest health, including wildfire, insects, disease, and drought

Manage values placed on forest ecosystems by local communities

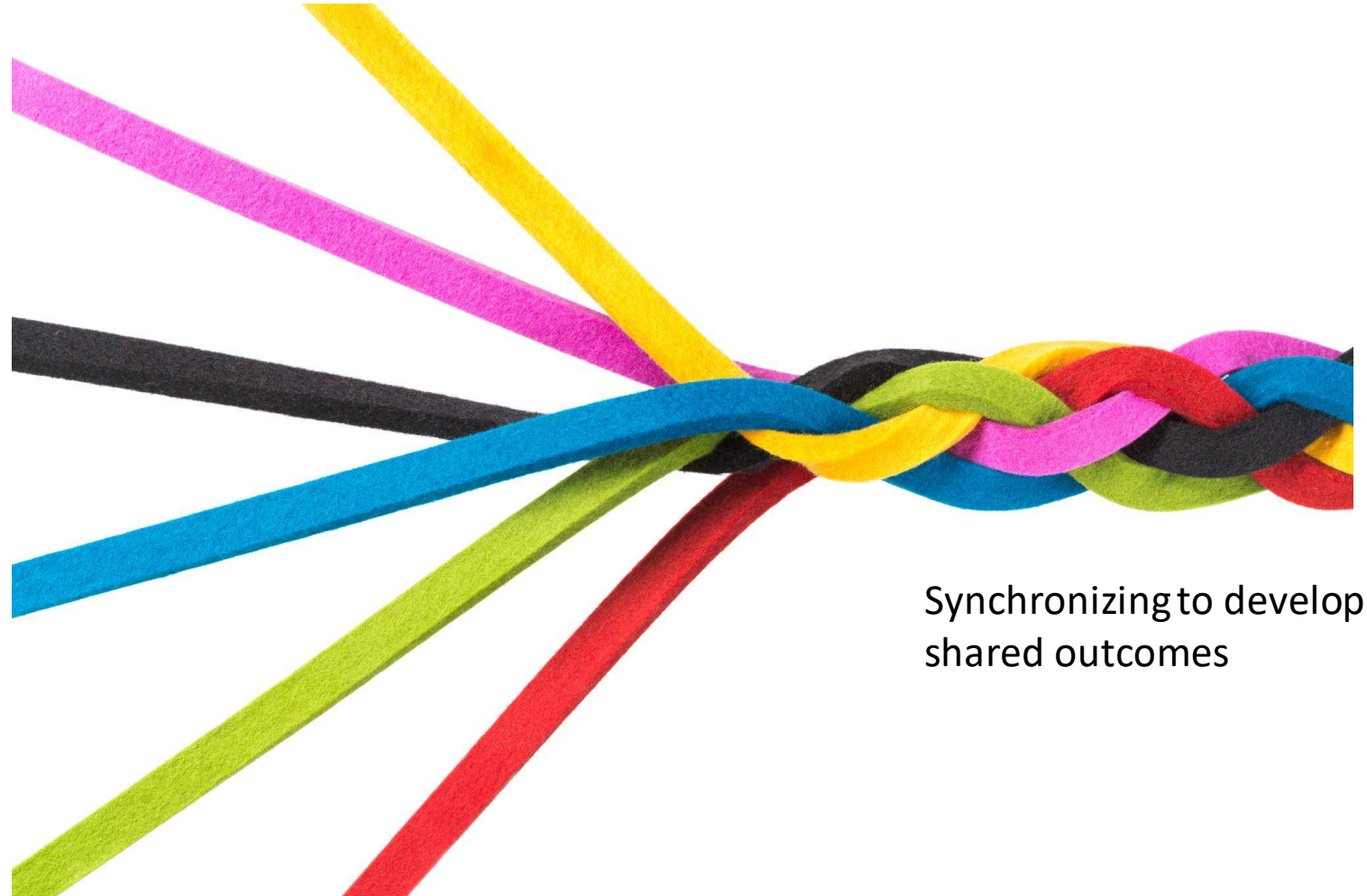

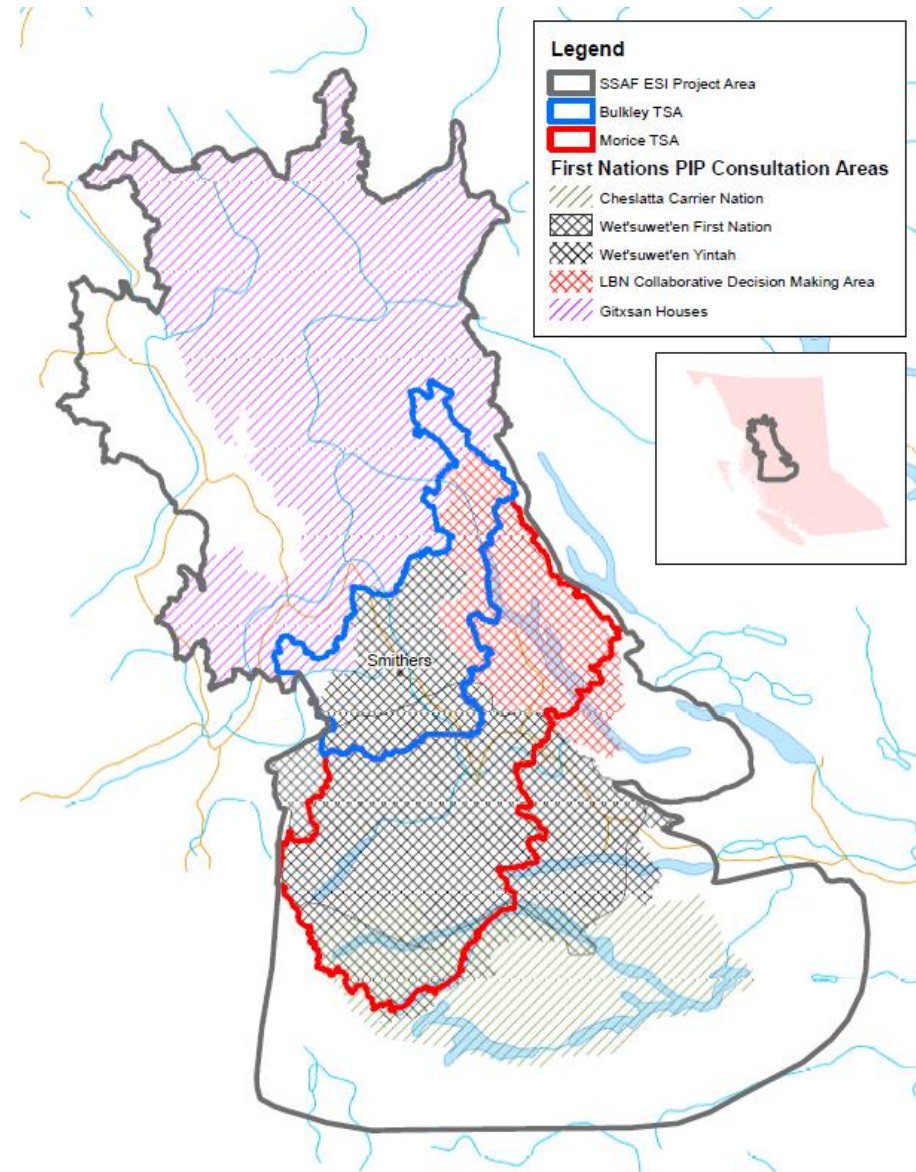

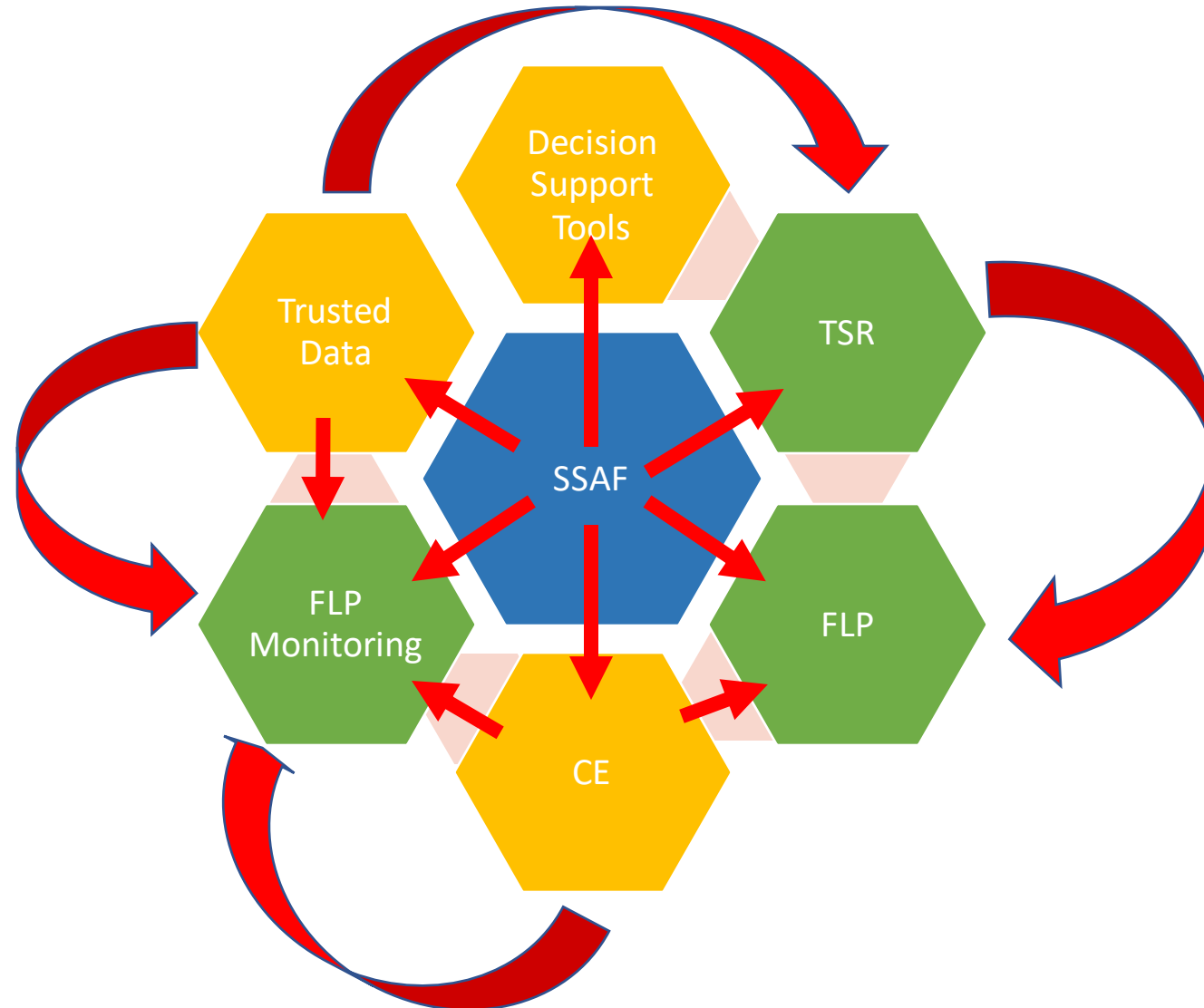
Bulkley & Morice Forest Landscape Planning Processes

Location of Bulkley and Morice TSAs relative to Skeena Sustainability Assessment Forum (SSAF) Project Area

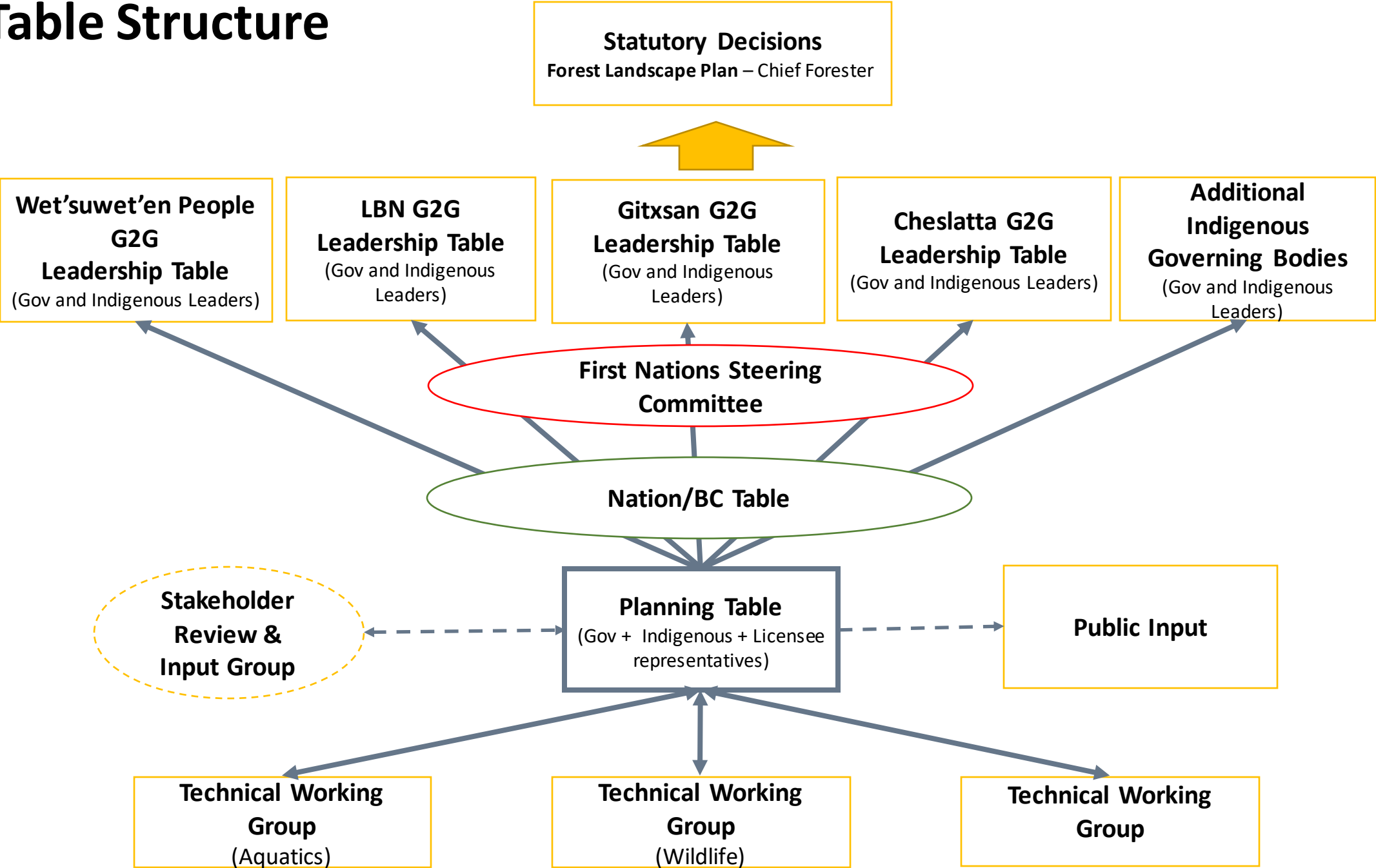


Integration Points/Sharing Resources

Stakeholder Review and Input Group

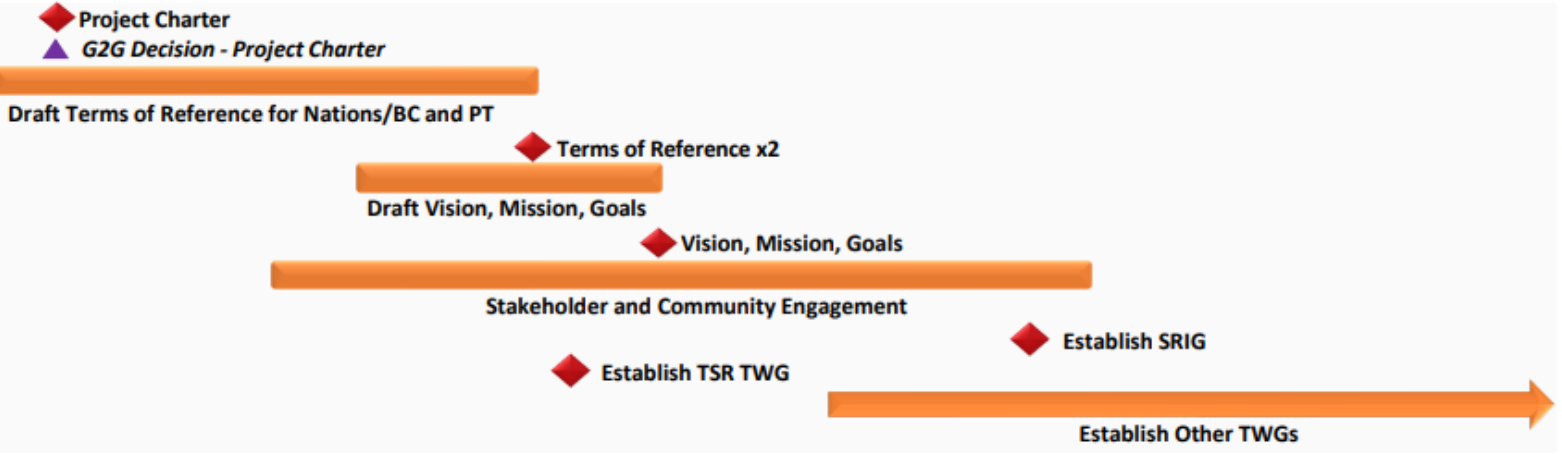

Bukley Morice FLP - 6 Month Timeline (DRAFT)



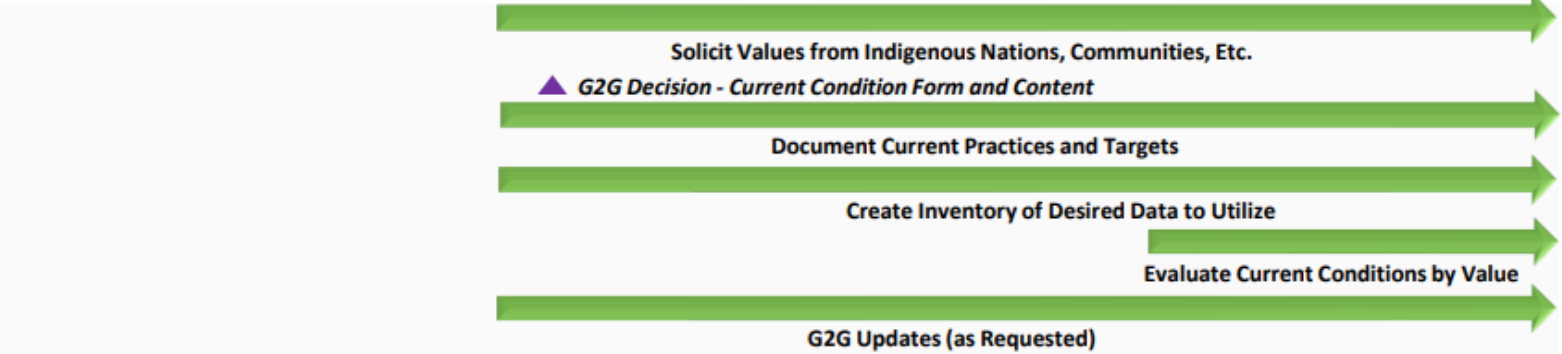

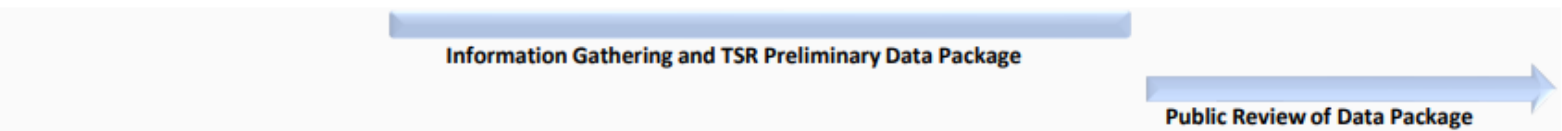
